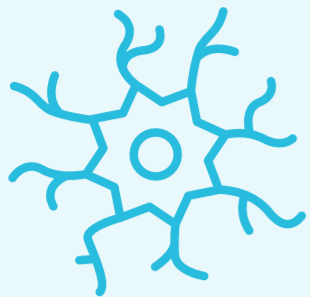


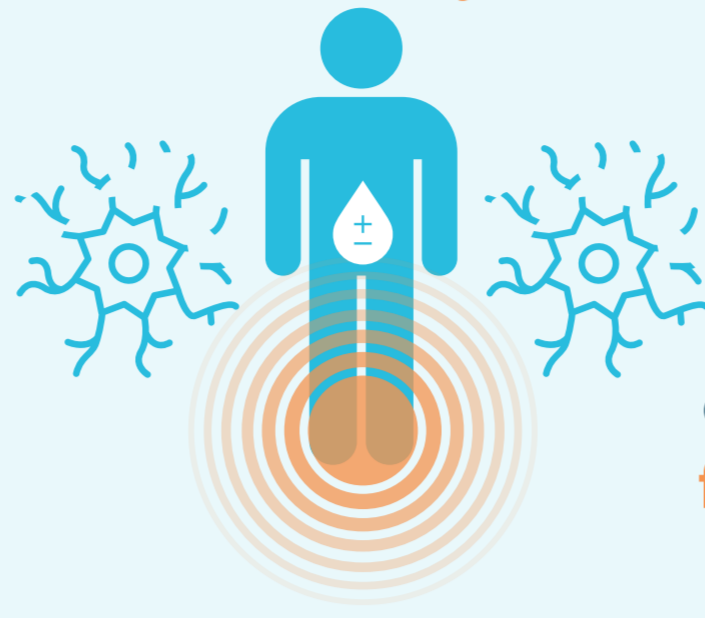
DIABETIC NERVE PAIN OF THE FEET AND YOU

WHAT IS DIABETIC FOOT NERVE PAIN?

Diabetic neuropathy is a type of nerve damage that can occur if you have diabetes¹



Diabetic nerve pain is one of its **most common complications**²



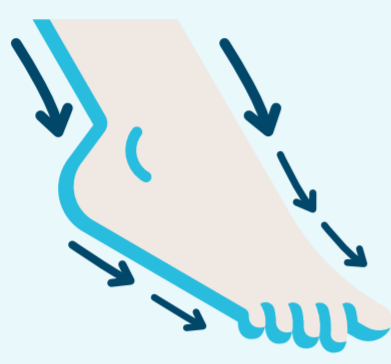
Nearly **60%** of diabetics have **some form of nerve damage**²



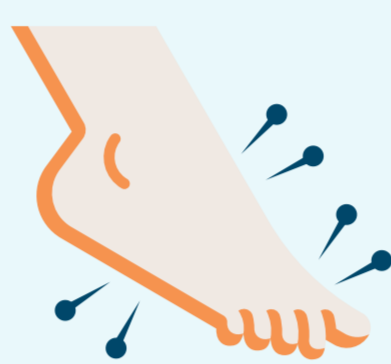
It is a progressive and debilitating complication of diabetes that will affect approximately more than **5 million Americans in 2021 and is expected to double by 2030**³⁻⁷

WHAT ARE TYPICAL PAIN SYMPTOMS TO THE FEET?

Pain symptoms that typically affect lower extremities include⁸:



Shooting



Stabbing



Burning

PATHWAY TO CORRECT DIAGNOSIS



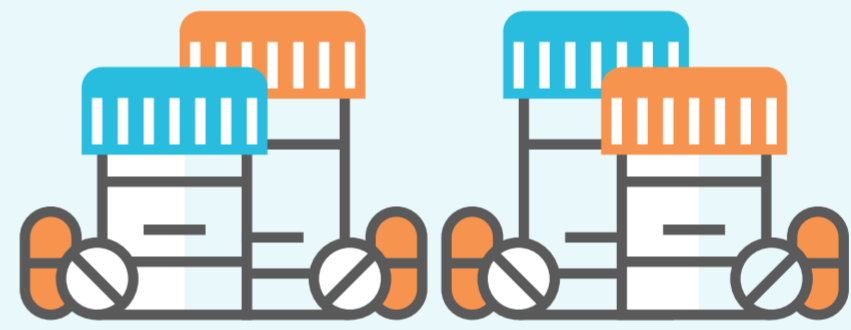
Less than **1 in 5 patients** had a correct diagnosis of by their **first doctor**⁹



2 in 5 patients had to **visit three or more doctors** before receiving the correct diagnosis⁹

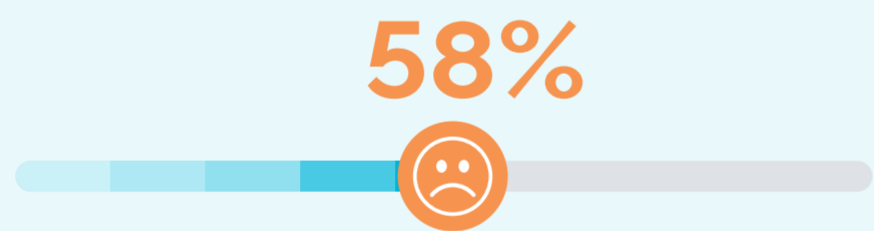
MEDICATION OF DIABETIC NERVE PAIN

70% of patients have taken **at least two different medications** to treat or manage their diabetic nerve foot pain⁹



Of those, **11% have taken four or more**⁹

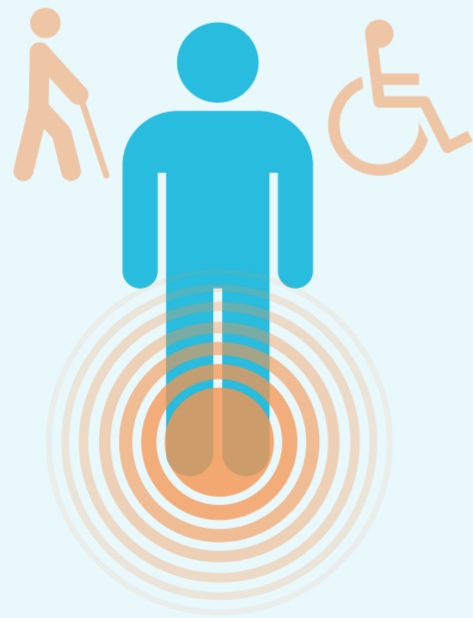
SATISFACTION OF TREATMENT PLAN



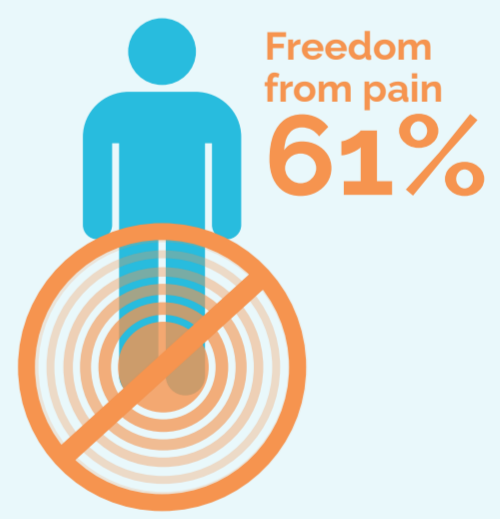
58% of patients are **not satisfied** with their current treatment plan⁹



90% of patients have had to **make significant lifestyle changes or adaptations**⁹



66% of patients regard themselves as **being disabled or having a disability** as a result of their diabetic nerve pain of the feet⁹



Better treatments (71%) and freedom from pain (61%) are the overriding perspectives **patients feel** when **thinking about the future**⁹
